Take notice that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the rules at N.J.A.C. 13:44C will expire on February 17, 2016. The rules establish standards for the licensing and regulation of audiologists and speech-language pathologists, including temporary licensure, continual professional education requirements, authorized practice, professional conduct, unlicensed practice, disciplinary actions, administration, and fees.

The Acting Director and the Committee have reviewed the rules and have determined them to be necessary, reasonable, and proper for the purpose for which they were originally promulgated, as required by Executive Order No. 66 (1978). Therefore, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:3B-24, and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.c(1), these rules are readopted and shall continue in effect for a seven-year period.
