**ORDER GRANTING IMPOUND

THIS MATTER being brought before the Court by Anne Milgram, Attorney General of New
Jersey, by Lorraine K. Rak, Deputy Attorney General, Chief, Consumer Fraud Prosecution Section,

appearing, attorney for plaintiffs Anne Milgram, Attorney General of the State of New Jersey, and Lawrence DeMarzo, Acting Director of the New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs (collectively, "Plaintiffs"), on a Motion seeking to impound merchandise in the possession of third parties as well as for distribution of merchandise, and the Court having considered the papers submitted and argument in support herein; and for good cause shown;


IT IS on this 5 day of November, 2008

ORDERED that, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 56:8-3(d), Plaintiffs impound and obtain possession of all merchandise relating to the provision of photography and/or videography services by defendants Marc A. Schwartz and Celebration Studios, Inc. (collectively, "Defendants") currently in the possession of any photographer, videographer, album manufacturer or other person including, but not limited to, photographs, negatives, proofs, digital files, videotapes, DVDs, servers, external hard drives, flash drives, backup tapes, albums and thank you cards;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all photographers, videographers, album manufacturers or other persons provide such merchandise to Plaintiffs Before November 14, 2008 ~~within ten (10) days of the date of this Order;~~

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ~~within twenty (20) days of the Plaintiffs' receipt of the merchandise from photographers, videographers, album manufacturers or any other person,~~ On November 21, 2008 Plaintiffs commence distribution of All ~~such~~ (provided above) merchandise as well as all merchandise previously impounded by the Plaintiffs pursuant to the Order Granting Impound, Asset Freeze and Preliminary Injunctive Relief, dated and filed January 25, 2008 (the "January 25 Order"); and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of the within Order shall be served upon the Defendants as well as all persons reflected in the attached Service List ^{Immediately this} ~~within seven (7) days of the~~ date hereof ~~date~~, and all consumers affected.
