

oughly examine the dog, did not provide an adequate work-up and failed to recognize that the dog was sorely in need of urinating, all of which endangered the life and health of the dog, and

(b) while treating Baron, a Dachshund owned by Mr. and Mrs. C. R. Anderegg, 11 Woodlawn Road, Sparta, N. J., he did not monitor the dog sufficiently and was careless in his treatment, which endangered the life and health of the dog.

3. Respondent has retained Robert Fisher, Esq., Young, Dorsey and Fisher, as his attorney in regard to the matter herein, and respondent has counselled with his attorney concerning the effect of this Order.

4. Respondent has received and read and fully understands the October 30, 1980, notice of allegations and charges and understands that the allegations and charges contained therein, if proved, would constitute cause for imposing disciplinary measures.

5. Respondent and his counsel are aware of each of respondent's rights, including the right to a hearing on the allegations and charges to make defense to any or all charges, the right to confront and to cross-examine witnesses who would testify against him, and the right to appeal any decision against him to the Superior Court, Appellate Division.

6. Respondent, rather than contesting the charges, freely and voluntarily waives his rights to a hearing or appeal and any and all other rights to which he is entitled in this matter under the laws of the State of New Jersey.

7. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as an admission by respondent of any act of misconduct alleged in the charges;

IT IS on this 16 day of April, 1981, HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent pay civil penalties in the amounts of \$250.00 for the first violation hereinbefore referred to and \$1,000.00 for the second violation hereinbefore referred to (a total of \$1,250.00).

2. Respondent submit to the Board as restitution to Mrs. Rebecca J. Tougas a check payable to Mrs. Rebecca J. Tougas in the amount of \$30.00.

3. Respondent submit to the Board as restitution to Mr. and Mrs. C. R. Anderegg a check payable to Mr. and Mrs. C. R. Anderegg in the amount of \$66.00.

4. If any of the provisions of this Consent Order are violated, said violation shall constitute additional grounds for immediate disciplinary action against respondent.
