FINAL ORDER

This matter having come before the Board on application for entry of final order in connection with the above complaints and the Board having considered the matters contained within the file, and the psychiatric report of Dr. Myron S. Denholtz and the Board having been advised that Dr. Michael Sananman makes no admissions with regard to the within complaints, and good cause appearing for the entry of the within Final Order,

It is on this 10 day of June, 1981,

ORDERED that the above captioned matter and the complaints be, and the same are hereby dismissed with prejudice and without

costs as to either party; and it is further

ORDERED that the complaints, pleadings, transcripts and all proceedings up to, but excluding this Final Order, including such proceedings which have taken place before the Office of Administrative Law, Docket No. BDS 1102-81, be and the same hereby are ordered sealed; and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Sananman shall consult with Dr. Denholtz (or if he is unavailable another similarly qualified doctor selected by the physician and approved by the Board) periodically approximately once every three (3) months over the next year and one-half for the purpose of continuing discussion on the issues of doctor/patient relationship, professional demeanor, professional ethics, and touching specifically on recognition of conscious or unconscious interpersonal influences separate from the specific physician services being rendered and situations including examinations in which a patient might misconstrue conduct of the physician.

Dr. Denholtz shall provide periodic reports to the Medical Board quarterly or more frequently at his discretion, should this be necessary; and it is further


ORDERED that, in connection with all examinations by Dr. Sananman of female patients, if medication which affects the senses is or has been currently administered or examination involves the patient's being in a state of undress, then such examinations shall be in the presence of another person who may be an adult member of the patient's family or a member of the doctor's staff or hospital, and it is further

ORDERED that all visits to and reports by Dr. Denholtz in connection with this matter be at the expense of the physician; and it is further

ORDERED that consistent with his present practice, the physician will keep all records of drug administration or patient examination on the applicable hospital or office records; and it is further

ORDERED that unless the Board affirmatively notifies the physician in writing for good cause shown, setting forth its reasons therefor, as to its intention to continue the terms of this Order, which notification shall be prior to the expiration of 18 months from the date hereof, then the provisions of this Order other than those providing for dismissal and sealing, shall expire. Any such continuance shall have no bearing on the dismissal and sealing entered herein, which Judgment of Dismissal is final as of the date hereof.


