the terms herein, and for good cause shown,


IT IS on this 4th day of June, 1982,

ORDERED that

1. Respondent Stephen M. Dempsey, D.V.M. shall have leave to
and hereby does retract his previously entered plea of not guilty and admits
the violations alleged in the Complaint herein;
2. Respondent shall be and hereby is reprimanded;
3. Respondent shall within ten (10) days pay a fine of \$500
by means of a certified check payable to the State of New Jersey and submitte
to the Board;
4. Respondent shall cease and desist from the wholesale
purchase of Schedule II Controlled Dangerous Substances for human consumption
and from personal use of Schedule II Controlled Dangerous Substances without

a prescription from a licensed physician.

5. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to indicate that Respondent purchased Controlled Dangerous Substances with intent to sell or distribute them to others outside the limits of his veterinary practice.






