ORDER OF LICENSURE,  
WITH LIMITATIONS

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners on June 30, 1982, on application of Robert S. Altin, M.D., of 390 Ocean Avenue, Long Branch, New Jersey 07740 requesting licensure by endorsement of his license in the State of Massachusetts. Dr. Altin has candidly acknowledged a prior problem with substance abuse and has discussed with the Board his active participation in counselling programs and work with impaired physicians' committees in Massachusetts and his willingness to continue same in the State of New Jersey.

It is clear that the conduct which took place in 1980 and 1981 is of the utmost gravity and were it not for Dr. Altin's affirmative actions in the interim, would clearly preclude licensure in this

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State. In the present circumstances, however, and relying upon Dr. Altin's good faith in pursuing rehabilitation measures,

IT IS on this 14th day of July, 1982,


ORDERED that a license to practice medicine and surgery in this State shall be issued to Robert S. Altin, M.D., which shall remain in good standing during his compliance with the following express conditions:


1. He shall continue to receive therapy by a Board approved therapist until further order of the Board;
2. He shall authorize the therapist to submit to this Board quarterly reports on his status and functioning; the therapist shall immediately advise the Board in the event of non-compliance with the therapy regimen or unilateral termination thereof by Dr. Altin;
3. Dr. Altin shall under no circumstances prescribe or administer to himself or prescribe in the name of any member of his family any Controlled Dangerous Substance or psychotropic medication;
4. He shall advise this Board in advance of commencing any private practice.
