Administrative Action

ORDER

This matter came before the New Jersey Board of Medical Examiners on May 19, 1982 by way of inquiry by the Executive Committee of the Board into certain medical procedures being conducted by Milan Q. Felt, M.D. More specifically the Board on notice to Dr. Felt inquired as to whether certain procedures being conducted violated the Board's prior order of March 24, 1980.

The Executive Committee discussed with Milan Q. Felt, M.D. his administering epi-dural injections of depo-medrol to patients. The Board is of the view that epi-dural injections involve the piercing of the patient's skin and a procedure invasive to the patient's body thus falling within the scope of surgery. The Board regards this procedure of epi-dural injections of depo-medrol as included within the prohibition set forth in the Board's Final Decision and Order dated March 24, 1980 limiting the medical practice of Milan Q. Felt, M.D. and prohibiting Dr. Felt from engaging in neurological surgery.



The Board has received and considered the correspondence of Milan Q. Felt, M.D. dated May 24, 1982 wherein Dr. Felt requested the Board reconsider the matter of epi-dural injections of depo-medrol, allow Dr. Felt to present witnesses on his behalf, and hold in abeyance any ruling on this matter until such rehearing has been completed. In addition, the Board has received and considered various letters from relatives of Dr. Felt who are receiving the epi-dural injections of depo-medrol. Essentially these letters request the Board to permit Dr. Felt to continue administering epi-dural injections of depo-medrol.

Having heard Dr. Felt during his appearance before the Executive Committee and having reviewed the materials submitted by Dr. Felt, the Board denies Dr. Felt's request for reconsideration and holding this matter in abeyance.

IT IS ON THIS 11 day of August, 1982
O R D E R E D :

That Milan Q. Felt, M.D., cease and desist from administering epi-dural injections of depo-medrol which are surgical procedures precluded under the terms of the prohibition contained in the Board's Final Decision dated March 24, 1980.
