ORDER FOR REINSTATEMENT
OF LICENSE

This matter was opened before the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners upon a request by Anthony Tangorra for a reinstatement of his license in view of his rehabilitation since the revocation of his license to practice chiropractic effective August 19, 1982. This revocation was based upon the conviction of Anthony Tangorra for the crime of mail fraud involving a conspiracy to obtain money from insurance companies by preparing false medical reports and other documents. In asserting his rehabilitation, Anthony Tangorra has submitted a letter dated March 8, 1983 from Robert E. Steede, U.S. Probation Officer, commenting favorably upon the continued good adjustment of Anthony Tangorra in the community. Two work performance evaluations of Tangorra were submitted to the Board showing him to be an excellent employer in a personnel department. The Board notes that Anthony Tangorra will remain on parole until November 1983 and has not practiced chiropractic for approximately 18 months while incarcerated and revoked.

In view of this information and for good cause:

IT IS ON THIS ^{25th} day of

April, 1983

ORDERED:

That the license number 1395 to practice chiropractic is hereby reinstated to Anthony Tangorra; and it is further

ORDERED:

That during his term of parole Anthony Tangorra shall practice chiropractic under the supervision of Gerald Sternback, D.C. who shall review all patient records and plans for the treatment; and it is further

ORDERED:

That during his term of parole, Anthony Tangorra shall submit no bills for services to third party payers; and it is further

ORDERED:

That Anthony Tangorra shall complete two (2) semesters of chiropractic clinical education.

This Order is effective upon filing.
