

Respondent submitted a statement in the manner of a certification which was filed and accepted by the Board on January 7, 1983.



that:


1. Respondent Eric Robinson, O.D. shall cease and desist from engaging in any of the following acts or practices until such time as the New Jersey Legislature modifies or amends N.J.S.A. 45:12 et seq. to permit the following acts or practices:
 - (a) The treatment by drugs of any ocular abnormality, disease or defect.
 - (b) The recommendation or performance of any therapeutic measure for the purpose of treating or alleviating symptoms of any ocular disease.
2. Respondent shall pay civil penalties in the amount of \$500.00. Said penalty shall be made within ten (10) days of the entry of this Final Order by certified check or money order payable to the New Jersey State Board of Optometrists.
3. This Final Order by consent constitutes a final

resolution of all matters arising from the
complaint in the instant matter.
