This matter coming before the Board of Medical Examiners upon the Complaint of the Attorney General of New Jersey, and the parties having agreed to settle the matter, and for good cause shown,

It is on this 19 day of March, 1984,

ORDERED that

1. The Respondent, Anthony J. Picaro, M.D., shall have leave to and hereby does enter a plea of no contest to the allegations of the Complaint, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey shall be and hereby is suspended for a period of one (1) year, said suspension being stayed and being a period of probation instead.

3. Respondent shall, within thirty (30) days of

the date of this Order, pay a civil penalty of \$2,500 by means of a certified check payable to the State of New Jersey and submitted to the Board.


4. Respondent shall, within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order, pay costs of \$6,696.72 by means of a certified check payable to the State of New Jersey and submitted to the Board.


5. Within one (1) year of the date of this Order, Respondent shall, at his own expense, register for and complete the entire Mini-Residency in Controlled Dangerous Substances (114 hours) offered by the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey.

6. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from the indiscriminate prescribing and/or dispensing of Controlled Dangerous Substances.
