Administrative Action
MODIFIED FINAL ORDER

A Final Decision and Order was entered by the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners in this matter on March 2, 1984, which order is incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth. By letter of February 21, 1984, respondent's counsel, Grace T. Meyer, Esq., requested that the Board reconsider the terms of that order to extend the date by which respondent shall make restitution to former patients. Specifically, respondent's counsel requests that the deadline for compliance be extended until September 15, 1984. Complainant raised no objection to this extension.

Respondent's counsel has also requested that the terms of the order be modified to eliminate the threat of license suspension in the event that respondent fails to comply with the other terms of the order. Complainant has objected to this modification, and the Board finds that the threat of suspension is warranted herein.

It is on this *9th* day of *april*, 1984,

ORDERED that the Final Decision and Order entered on March 2, 1984 shall be modified as follows:

1. For each and every patient to whom \$45.00 is not restored by September 15, 1984, respondent shall pay to the Board a penalty of \$95.00 per unpaid patient in lieu of restitution, said penalty to be paid by certified check made out to the State Board of Medical Examiners, by October 1, 1984.

2. Should respondent fail to comply with this Order in all respects by October 1, 1984, his license to practice chiropractic in the State of New Jersey shall be suspended for one year, commencing October 1, 1984.
