Administrative Action  
FINAL ORDER

This matter having been opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners by Administrative Complaint filed February 1, 1984 alleging that Dr. Huang prescribed the Schedule IV Controlled Dangerous Substances Fastin, Ionamin and Serax to one undercover investigator of the State without valid medical cause or proper examination, and in an indiscriminate manner on ten occasions over the period October 1979 to October 1980 and Dr. Huang pleading non vult to these allegations, and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 12<sup>th</sup> DAY OF MAY, 1984,  
HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

CERTIFIED TRUE COPY

1. Dr. Huang shall cease and desist from the prescription or dispensing of Controlled Dangerous Substances without valid medical cause.

2. The medical license of Ming Yuan Huang be and hereby is suspended for a period of two years, but that the suspension is stayed and becomes a period of probation.

3. Dr. Huang shall pay a civil penalty of \$2,500.00 by certified check or money order made out to the State Board of Medical Examiners within ten (10) days of receipt of this Order.



4. Dr. Huang shall pay costs of \$680.00 to the State to cover the costs of its investigation by certified check or money order made out to the State Board of Medical Examiners within ten (10) days of receipt of this Order.

5. Dr. Huang shall complete the entire mini drug abuse course offered by the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey within 12 months.
