: FINAL ORDER
TO PRACTICE CHIROPRACTIC IN :
THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY :

This matter was opened to the Board of Medical Examiners by way of Complaint of the Attorney General charging respondent with practicing chiropractic since September 1, 1979 without having renewed his biennial certificate of registration, and with treating horses by chiropractic adjustment, which conduct constitutes the unlicensed practice of veterinary medicine and further constitutes practicing chiropractic beyond the lawful scope conveyed by his chiropractic license. On motion of the Attorney General a preliminary restraining order was entered on May 9, 1984 with the consent of respondent, requiring him to cease and desist from treating animals by chiropractic adjustment pending disposition of the complaint. In order to resolve the matter respondent has consented to the entry of the within order, hereby waiving any right to a hearing on the

issues raised by the complaint, and it appearing that the entry of the within order shall adequately protect and serve the public interest and for good cause shown;

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS *21st* DAY OF *September*, 1984

ORDERED that respondent Frank Perruso, D.C., shall cease and desist from the practice of chiropractic on animals and from holding himself out as being entitled to do so within the lawful scope of his license as a chiropractor in the State of New Jersey; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall pay a penalty of \$1,000.00 by way of a certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and submitted to the Board offices within ten (10) days of the service of this order; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent Frank Perruso, D.C., is reprimanded for treating animals by chiropractic adjustment and for holding himself out as practicing within the scope of his chiropractic license in rendering such treatment to animals; and it is further

ORDERED that entry of the within order shall be deemed a final determination of any factual or legal defense which was or may have been asserted to the complaint filed herein.
