

determined that he should be deemed ineligible for licensure and would not be permitted to reapply until March 16, 1989, five years from the date of his first application. Further, the Board directed that he would no longer be deemed eligible to practice medicine in the context of a residency training program, pursuant to the exemption set forth at N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(d) effective October 23, 1984. Dr. Copare filed a Notice of Appeal with the Appellate Division of the New Jersey Superior Court on December 28, 1984.

The Board having reconsidered its determination and Dr. Copare having agreed to the dismissal of his appeal, with prejudice, and without costs,

IT IS on this *22nd* day of *July*, 1985.

AGREED AND ORDERED:

1. Dr. Copare shall, within ten (10) days of the entry of this Order, file with the Appellate Division of the Superior Court, a Stipulation of Dismissal of his pending appeal, with prejudice and without costs.
2. Dr. Copare shall not practice medicine and surgery in any setting in New Jersey until June 30, 1986. Thereafter, he shall be deemed eligible to participate in a residency or other post graduate training program in the State of New Jersey, provided that his participation and his practice will be limited to that permitted of an unlicensed physician, subject to the supervision of a licensed physician.

3. Dr. Copare will continue to be deemed ineligible for licensure in this State until March 16, 1989, five (5) years from the date on which he initially sought licensure. He may thereafter reapply for licensure in this State, and his application will be reviewed in the normal course. The misrepresentation, which was the basis for the Board's Order of October 23, 1984, will not, in and of itself, be a basis for the denial of his reapplication, though the Board may undertake to question Dr. Copare regarding his underlying medical education and his activities since the Board's decision.
