CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the State Board of Dentistry ("Board") by way of Complaint filed October 24, 1986, by W. Cary Edwards, Attorney General of New Jersey, by Kathy Rohr, Deputy Attorney General, alleging that in or about the period April 1984 through August 1984, respondent, Leonard E. Noud, D.D.S., submitted claims to an insurance company on behalf of patient R.M. for higher fees for services than those represented to the patient and/or for benefits for services never rendered and failed to maintain an accurate patient record. The Complaint alleges that the conduct of respondent constitutes the use or employment of dishonesty, fraud, deception, misrepresentation, false promise or false pretense within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b), professional misconduct within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e) and N.J.A.C. 13:30-8.12, and failure to comply with a Board regulation within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h) and N.J.A.C. 13:30-8.8.

On or about November 6, 1986, respondent entered a denial to all of the charges of the Complaint.

It now appears that the parties wish to resolve and settle this matter on a consensual basis without a hearing and that good cause exists for the entry of this Order.


THEREFORE, it is on this *8th* day of *June*, 1987,
ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars to be paid to the State of New Jersey. Payment shall be made by certified check payable to the State of New Jersey and shall be sent to William Gutman, Executive Director, State Board of Dentistry, 1100 Raymond Boulevard, Room 321, Newark, New Jersey 07102 by July 1, 1987.

2. Respondent agrees that he shall not intentionally submit any insurance claims on behalf of patients which are deceptive or misrepresentative of service rendered or of charges made.


3. Respondent is hereby suspended from the practice of dentistry for a period of ninety (90) days, which suspension shall be stayed and remain inactive contingent upon respondent's compliance with all terms and conditions of this Order.

4. Respondent is hereby reprimanded and cautioned that more serious penalties will be imposed in the event subsequent complaints of a similar nature are filed against him.


