ORDERED AND AGREED:

1. Brian T. Donohue does hereby immediately
resign and surrender his license to practice veterinary

medicine in the State of New Jersey. This resignation shall be without prejudice.

2. Brian T. Donohue shall restore the sum of \$ 215.00 to Jeff Block by tendering a certified check payable to Jeff Block in said amount to the Board's executive director contemporaneously with the entry of this Order.

3. In the event that Brian T. Donahue shall seek to reinstate his license to practice veterinary medicine in New Jersey, he shall appear before the Board and demonstrate to its satisfaction, that he meets the requirements for licensure as a precondition to reinstatement thereof.
