This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry upon the receipt of information that Gerald Rossnick, D.D.S., had been arrested on three charges of sexual assault, three charges of endangering the welfare of a child, two charges of child abuse and one charge of aggravated sexual assault. Subsequent investigation by the Division of Consumer Affairs Enforcement Bureau disclosed that Dr. Rossnick's dental office, located at 868 Broadway, Bayonne, New Jersey, was filthy, unsanitary and unhealthy. Additionally, the Enforcement Bureau investigation disclosed that Dr. Rossnick engaged in indiscriminate prescribing and/or dispensing of Controlled Dangerous Substances. Based on Dr. Rossnick's representations that his dental office will be cleaned and placed in a sanitary condition immediately, and in order to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings and for good cause shown,

IT IS ON THIS *21st* DAY OF *Sept.*, 1988,

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Gerald Rossnick, D.D.S., shall voluntarily surrender his license to practice dentistry in New Jersey with prejudice on or before October 1, 1988. Dr. Rossnick shall not undertake to accept or treat any new patients between now, the effective date of this Order, and October 1, 1988; Dr. Rossnick's practice shall be limited to those actions necessary to effect an orderly sale and transfer of his dental practice.

2. Dr. Rossnick shall immediately take steps to clean his dental office and place it in a sanitary condition. This Order shall not be entered by the Board unless an inspection conducted by the Division of Consumer Affairs Enforcement Bureau on or about September 9, 1988 discloses that Dr. Rossnick's office is fit to be operated as a dental office. In order for Dr. Rossnick's dental office to pass the inspection, he must correct those deficiencies outlined in the inspection report previously provided to him.

3. Dr. Rossnick shall immediately surrender all privileges pertaining to prescribing or dispensing of Controlled Dangerous Substances, all Schedules.


4. Dr. Rossnick shall have an attendant present in the room at all times when a patient is being examined or treated. Dr. Rossnick shall be responsible to ensure that the attendant present shall initial or sign the patient chart to verify that the attendant was present for the entire examination


and/or treatment of the patient. Dr. Rossnick shall inform the Board of Dentistry in writing of the name of all attendants.

5. Dr. Rossnick shall pay costs to the State of New Jersey in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty-six Dollars and Fifty-six (\$2,556.56) cents within two (2) years of the effective date of this Order.
