IT IS ON THIS 7th DAY OF March, 1990,


HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Dr. Berke shall make restitution to Gwen DiGiovanni in the amount of Three Hundred and Fifty-five (\$355.00) Dollars by submitting a certified check or money order in the aforesaid amount made payable to Gwen DiGiovanni to the State Board of

Dentistry at 1100 Raymond Boulevard, Room 510, Newark, New Jersey 07102, within thirty (30) days of the entry date of this Order.


2. Dr. Berke shall make restitution to Aetna Life and Casualty Insurance Company (on behalf of Gwen DiGiovanni) in the amount of Three Hundred and Fifty-five (\$355.00) Dollars by submitting a certified check or money order in the aforesaid amount made payable to Aetna Life & Casualty Insurance Company to the State Board of Dentistry at 1100 Raymond Boulevard, Room 510, Newark, New Jersey 07102, within thirty (30) days of the entry date of this Order.

3. Dr. Berke shall successfully complete twenty (20) hours of continuing education in root canal therapy and ten (10) hours of continuing education in post and core preparation for a total of thirty (30) hours of continuing education. These courses shall be approved by the Board in writing prior to attendance. The continuing education courses must be completed within six (6) months of the entry date of this Order. Dr. Berke shall also be required to provide the Board with proof of successful completion of the required course work.


