AMENDED ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry upon the request of Anthony Lee Pflieger, D.M.D., for an amendment to the Consent Order filed by the Board on October 9, 1986, concerning the requirement that he work only as an employee and under the direct supervision of a New Jersey licensed dentist. In connection with this application, the Board referred Dr. Pflieger for a psychological examination to Frank Dyer, Ph.D. Dr. Dyer concluded and recommended that the restrictions on Dr. Pflieger's license be lifted with the exception of mandatory periodic reporting by a psychiatrist to assure compliance with treatment. The Board having reviewed this evaluation and the entire record in this matter, and the Board being satisfied that good cause exists for the entry of this Order,

IT IS ON THIS 20th DAY OF *April*, 1990,
HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Interim Consent Order of Reinstatement of License with Limitations entered and filed by the Board on October 9, 1986, shall be amended to eliminate the requirement that Dr. Pflieger practice in this State only as an employee and under the

direct, on-premises supervision of a New Jersey licensed dentist.

2. All other terms and conditions of the aforementioned Consent Order that are not inconsistent with the within Order shall continue in full force and effect. A copy of said Order is attached to this Amended Order and is made a part hereof.

INTERIM CONSENT ORDER OF
REINSTATEMENT OF
LICENSE WITH LIMITATIONS

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry upon the application of respondent, Anthony Lee Pflieger, D.M.D., for reinstatement of his license to practice dentistry which had been temporarily suspended by order of the Board dated May 8, 1985 pending plenary hearing on the administrative action complaint filed by the Attorney General of New Jersey by Maxine H. Neuhauser, Deputy Attorney General. In support of his application for reinstatement, Dr. Pflieger presented psychiatric evaluations by a Board appointed psychiatrist, George F. Wilson, M.D., and by respondent's own treating psychiatrist, Steven J. Glass, M.D. The Board having reviewed these evaluations and it being satisfied that good cause exists for the entry of this order,

IT IS ON THIS 6th DAY OF October, 1986,

HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The license to practice dentistry of respondent, Anthony Lee Pflieger, D.M.D., is hereby temporarily reinstated with the following limitations pending final action on the administrative action amended complaint:

a. Respondent shall practice in this State only as an employee and under the direct, on-premises supervision of a New Jersey licensed dentist.

b. Dr. Pflieger shall inform the State Board of Dentistry when he resumes practice in New Jersey and shall further inform the Board of the name and office address of his employer.

c. Respondent shall see his psychiatrist monthly and shall authorize him to submit quarterly evaluations to the State Board of Dentistry and shall further authorize him to notify the Board immediately if he diagnosis a deterioration in Dr. Pflieger's mental condition. In the event that such notification is made to the Board, respondent's license shall be immediately suspended pending formal hearing on the matter.


d. Respondent shall submit to quarterly psychiatric evaluations at his own expense with a Board appointed psychiatrist who shall submit an evaluation to the Board. In the event that such an evaluation reports a deterioration in Dr. Pflieger's mental condition, respondent's license shall be immediately suspended pending formal hearing on the matter.

e. In the event that respondent wishes to continue psychiatric treatment with someone other than his current psychiatrist, he shall, inform the Board of the name and address of the new psychiatrist and shall provide new authorizations in accordance with paragraph c above.

f. Respondent shall provide a copy to the Board of the above required authorization given to his current treating psychiatrist.


g. This order shall remain in effect until a final order on the amended complaint is filed

with the Board.


