CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners upon receipt of information that respondent administered to a patient 13, 825 milligrams of Demerol, a Schedule II Controlled Dangerous Substance in a seven month period beginning April 5, 1988 and ending October 17, 1988. In addition, respondent was aware that a patient was being prescribed Demerol by her treating physician, and therefore aware that she was consuming excessive amounts of Demerol. Respondent admitted that he was concerned about risk of drug dependency and he and the treating physician monitored this patient closely in an attempt to ensure that she did not manifest signs of physical or psychological addiction.

The parties being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of formal proceedings, and it appearing that respondent has read and understands the terms of the within Order, and consents to be bound by same, and it further appearing that the within Order is adequately protective of the public interest, and good cause therefore exist for the entry of the within Order,

IT IS on this 5 day of December, 1990

ORDERED:

1. Dr. Boudwin shall be and is hereby formally reprimanded by the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners.

2. Respondent shall be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00. Said sums are to be paid by certified check or money order to the State of New Jersey in such installments as may be approved by the Board office. Failure to remit any installments within five (5) days of the date on which it was due, will cause the entire amount to be due and owing.
