MILUTA VACS, Unlicensed	:	CONSENT ORDER AND AGREEMENT

This matter was opened to the State Board of Dentistry ("Board"), upon receipt of information which disclosed that Miluta Vacs engaged in the unlicensed practice of dentistry in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:6-13 in that he fabricated dentures for a patient without a dentist's prescription. The parties being desirous of resolving this matter without recourse to formal proceedings and Miluta Vacs voluntarily submitting to the jurisdiction of the Board for the purpose of entering the within Order, and in consideration of the Board's forbearance from instituting litigation seeking injunctive relief and the assessment of a penalty for the unlicensed practice of dentistry, and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 6th DAY OF February, 1991

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Miluta Vacs shall not engage in the unlicensed practice of dentistry in any manner whatsoever, with or without compensation, including offers to assist friends and relatives or any other persons, or holding himself out or representing himself as a dentist, or conducting any form of dental examination, or fabricating dentures without a dentist's prescription, or taking impressions of the human tooth, teeth, jaws or performing any phase of any operation incident to the replacement of a part of a tooth, teeth or associated tissues, or otherwise engaging in acts of dentistry as defined in N.J.S.A. 45:6-19.

2. Miluta Vacs shall be required to dispose of all dental chair(s), if any, in his possession and all dental equipment, appliances, tools, instruments, medications or dental products that would normally be for intra-oral use by a dentist, including but not limited to impression trays for intra-oral use, mouth mirrors and dental lights which are in his possession at any location. He shall be required to sell or dispose of all such items through a legitimate dealer in dental supplies and equipment or to a New Jersey licensed dentist. In the event of any questions concerning the propriety or manner of disposal of any items, he shall contact the Board of Dentistry to determine the appropriate manner of disposing of any such item. Miluta Vacs shall be required to submit to the office of Executive Director, State Board of Dentistry at 1207 Raymond Boulevard, Newark, New Jersey 07102, bills of sale, receipts or other documentation verifying the disposal of all such items no later than thirty (30) days after the entry date of this Order.


3. Miluta Vacs shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars within 45 days of the entry of this order, by certified check or money order payable to the State of New Jersey and mailed to the State Board of Dentistry at 1207 Raymond Boulevard, Newark, New Jersey 07102.

4. In the event that Miluta Vacs engages in the practice of dentistry hereafter, the Attorney General, acting on behalf of the Board, is hereby authorized to seek and obtain preliminary injunctive relief in the Superior Court without notice to Miluta Vacs and said relief may be granted on a duly verified petition to the Court.
