

at the Diagnostic Treatment Center in Fort Lee since December 1990. During that employment he interviewed and examined patients in the presence of his employer, Michael G. Vincent, M.D., who also reviewed all of his charts on a daily basis. Dr. Brizuela was paid one half of what he would receive if he were a licensed physician. Dr. Brizuela did not inform the program director of his residency that he was employed at the Diagnostic Treatment Center. Based on those facts the Board found that Dr. Brizuela had been engaged in the practice of medicine.

The parties being desirous of resolving this matter, and the Board finding that the within Consent Order is adequately protective of the public interest;

IT IS on this 17th day of JUNE , 1991,

ORDERED that Dr. Brizuela be and hereby is REPRIMANDED for the unlicensed practice of medicine, and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Brizuela shall either pay a civil penalty of \$2,500 or, in the alternative, complete 250 hours of community service acceptable to the Board, the choice of sanction to be selected by Dr. Brizuela. The monetary penalty shall be paid in full in monthly installments to be determined by the Board, or the community service shall be completed, by June 1992, and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Brizuela shall take and pass by June 1992 an ethics course acceptable to the Board, and it is further

ORDERED that upon receipt at the Board offices of a signed copy of this Consent Order, a license to practice medicine and surgery in this State shall be issued to Dr. Brizuela, such license being subject to suspension, revocation or restrictions should Dr. Brizuela fail to comply with any part of this Order.
