AMENDED ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry upon receipt of an application for a modification of the terms of the Consent Order entered on December 1, 1990 from Judd Wayne Garson, D.D.S. by and through his counsel, Pamela Mandel, Esq. The Board having reviewed the entire record in this matter including the reports submitted in support of the application from Dr. Frederick Rotgers, Staff Clinician of the NJDA Chemical Dependency Program, and Dr. William Frankenstein, Dr. Garson's treating therapist, and the Board finding that good cause exists for the entry of the within Order,

IT IS ON THIS 28<sup>th</sup> DAY OF Aug., 1991,  
HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Effective September 1, 1991, Dr. Garson shall have his urine monitored under the supervision of the Impaired Dentists

Program on a random, unannounced basis, once weekly for a period of ninety (90) days. Thereafter, the frequency of urine monitoring shall be reduced to once every two weeks for the following ninety (90) days, and thereafter the urine monitoring shall be further reduced to once monthly.

2. Dr. Garson shall specifically authorize Dr. William Frankenstein to notify the Impaired Dentists Program immediately in the event Dr. Frankenstein knows or has some reason to suspect that Dr. Garson has resumed any consumption of alcohol and/or other substance abuse.

3. All other terms and conditions contained in the Consent Order entered by the Board on December 1, 1991, that are not inconsistent with the within Order shall continue in full force and effect and are hereby incorporated by reference.
