This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry upon receipt of a patient complaint from Luis E. Palacios concerning the dental services rendered by Roni Golden, D.M.D. including, but not limited to, the provision of a partial denture. The Board reviewed the patient's records, the report of the Board's consultant, the dental insurance forms, and acquired further information at an investigative inquiry attended by Dr. Golden on August 28, 1991. It appearing that the parties wish to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 27th DAY OF ~~OCTOBER~~, ^{NOVEMBER}, 1991,

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Dr. Golden shall make restitution to the patient by submitting certified checks or money orders made payable to Luis

E. Palacios in the amount of Six Hundred and Twenty-three (\$623.00) Dollars and New Jersey Blue Cross/Blue Shield Dental Program in the amount of One Hundred Eighty-two (\$182.00) Dollars to the Board office no later than the first day of the month following the entry date of this Order.

2. Dr. Golden is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for professional misconduct in that the insurance claim forms submitted to the patient's insurance carrier contained treatment dates which did not accurately reflect the date when the service or procedure was actually completed and description of a dental service (#13 amalgam) which was not performed in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:30-8.10.

3. Dr. Golden is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for poor record keeping in that the patient record maintained for Luis E. Palacios failed to meet the minimum requirements of N.J.A.C. 13:30-8.7 in that they failed to include an accurate date of each patient visit and an accurate description of the treatment or services rendered at each visit.

4. Dr. Golden is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars for a failure to diagnose and treat numerous decayed areas and provided to the patient a partial denture in the presence of a periodontal condition and untreated caries.

5. The above civil penalties shall be submitted to the Board office by certified check or money order made payable to

the State of New Jersey no later than the first day of the month following the entry date of this Order.


6. Dr. Golden shall successfully complete twenty (20) hours of continuing education in periodontal dentistry and twenty (20) hours of continuing education in restorative dentistry. These courses shall be approved by the Board in writing prior to attendance and must be completed within six (6) months of the entry date of this Order. Dr. Golden also shall be required to provide the Board with written proof of successful completion of the required course work.

7. Dr. Golden shall be permitted to make arrangements to pay the civil penalties required herein on an installment basis over a one (1) year period of time. Dr. Golden shall be provided in writing with the amount of the monthly payment and the monthly due date. Any failure to make a monthly payment shall cause the entire balance of the civil penalty to become immediately due and payable.
