AMENDED ORDER

TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY IN THE :
STATE OF NEW JERSEY :

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry by the application of Steven Hutt, D.D.S. for a modification of the Consent Order. The Board having had the opportunity to review the letter of Dr. Frederick Rotgers, Director of the N.J.D.A. Chemical Dependency Program; memorandum of Reginald Jenkins, M.D. concerning Dr. Hutt's successful completion of his community service; Order of Dismissal dated November 27, 1991 in the matter of State of New Jersey v. Steven Hutt and letter of Dr. Ostreicher. The Board finding that good cause exists to modify the consent order.

IT IS ON THIS 19th DAY OF May 1992,
ORDERED THAT:

1. The license of Steven Hutt, D.D.S. to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey shall be suspended for a period of five (5) years from April 5, 1991. Said suspension shall be stayed until further order of this Board.

2. Dr. Hutt shall have his urine monitored under the supervision of the Impaired Dentists Program according to the following schedule:

A. Once weekly during the first six (6) months from the entry date of this order.

B. Twice monthly during the next subsequent six (6) months from the entry date of this order.

Dr. Hutt shall be permitted to move before this Board for modification of this above-described schedule one (1) year after the entry date of this order.

3. Until further order of this Board, Dr. Hutt shall not prescribe or dispense Schedule I, II and III Controlled Dangerous Substances for his personal use or the use of others nor shall he possess such substances except pursuant to a bona fide prescription written by a physician or dentist for good medical or dental cause.

4. Dr. Hutt shall be permitted to prescribe or dispense Schedule IV Controlled Dangerous Substance for patient as required in connection with dental treatment, in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

A. Dr. Hutt shall obtain and exclusively employ prescription pads which provide triplicate copies

of each prescription and which are consecutively numbered.

B. Dr. Hutt shall provide the original of the prescription to the patient, he shall place one copy in the patient's chart, and he shall submit one copy of all prescriptions to the Board on a monthly basis. Dr. Hutt shall be required to account for each consecutive number, regardless of whether the particular prescription was voided or not used for any purpose whatsoever.

C. Dr. Hutt shall submit copies of these prescriptions in consecutive order no later than the fifth (5th) day of each month for all prescriptions written in the previous month. These shall be submitted to Agnes Clarke, Executive Director of the Board, 124 Halsey Street, 6th Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07102, so that they may be reviewed and monitored by the Board.

5. All other conditions of the Consent Order entered by the Board as of April 9, 1991 which are not consistent with this Order shall be continued.

6. Dr. Hutt may apply for modification of the terms and conditions of the within Order no sooner than one (1) year from the entry date herein.
