IT IS on this 8th day of July, 1992,

ORDERED that this matter be and hereby is adjourned until the 12th day of August, 1992, upon which date the Board at its regular meeting shall hear and consider on a summary basis the application for the imposition of temporary restraints on the practice of respondent pending plenary hearing, and it is further

ORDERED that Frederick Coville M.D. shall neither examine nor treat any patient and shall close his office for the practice of medicine effective 5 p.m. Friday, July 10, 1992, pending the above summary hearing, and it is further

ORDERED that copies of all documents to be offered in evidence on behalf of respondent, including but not limited to all medical records, photographs or other items previously subpoenaed by the Office of the Attorney General, shall be submitted to the Deputy Attorney General no less than seven days prior to the summary hearing, and it is further

ORDERED that the names of any and all persons who are

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identified by initials in the complaint in this matter shall not be disclosed except as may be necessary in the conduct of further hearing or investigation.
