This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon the receipt of information that Alan Chant knowingly and purposely committed theft of Controlled Dangerous Substance from his employer's pharmacy stock for his personal use. It appearing that in lieu of a proceeding to temporarily suspend respondent's license to practice pharmacy pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22, respondent has voluntarily agreed to refrain from further practice of pharmacy effective April 15, 1996, and to surrender his original certificate and license renewal pending a plenary hearing before the Board which shall be scheduled by the Board upon respondent's application for relicensure,

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 24<sup>th</sup> DAY OF April, 1996,

ORDERED AND AGREED that effective April 15, 1996 pending further Order of the Board, respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy including the following: respondent shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; he shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; he shall not handle prescriptions; he shall not advise or consult with patients, and he is prohibited from being present within a prescription filling area of a pharmacy, and it is further

ORDERED AND AGREED that respondent shall by execution of the within Order authorize the surrender of his original wall certificate, his wallet certificate, and his most recent renewal card of his license to an authorized representative of the Board, and it is further

ORDERED AND AGREED that nothing herein provided shall preclude the Board from affirmatively initiating any action, which may be authorized by law, at such time as the Board may deem it appropriate.
