SUPPLEMENT TO AMENDED ORDER OF
LIMITED REINSTATEMENT
OF LICENSE

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners upon Dr. Fogari's request to amend the prior Order of the Board which granted a limited reinstatement of license. The amendment would permit his participation in a PGY-4 level fellowship at Hahnemann University in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The Board previously approved Dr. Fogari's service in a clinical fellowship at Jefferson Medical College to satisfy a portion of the re-education previously mandated in this matter. That fellowship has apparently been withdrawn. The Board will permit Dr. Fogari to engage in the clinical fellowship, at Hahnemann University so long as it meets the requirements set forth below. The Board has once again determined to issue a license limited to the specific training program which has

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offered Dr. Fogari a position. All provisions of this Board's amended and prior orders denying reinstatement and granting permit shall remain effective as modified below.

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 22 DAY OF June, 1993,
ORDERED: NUNC PRO TUNC JUNE 17, 1993

1. That Dr. Robert A. Fogari is hereby granted a limited license for the sole purpose of engaging in the activities specified in paragraph number 2.


2. That the medical practice of Dr. Robert A. Fogari shall be restricted to a clinical fellowship in rheumatology at Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, under supervision.

3. Dr. Fogari shall be responsible to insure that the Board shall receive a status report from the fellowship program regarding his participation and progress by the Director of such program every month during its course, beginning 30 days after the commencement of the fellowship. Dr. Fogari's continued limited licensure shall be conditioned upon his continued adequate performance as determined by the Board.

4. Following successful conclusion of three years of residency/fellowship training, Dr. Fogari may appear before a Committee of the Board of Medical Examiners which will review his progress and consider reinstatement of his license. For that purpose, the fellowship at Hahnemann University shall satisfy only those number of months toward the 36 month requirement during which Dr. Fogari actually participates in the fellowship. At such time as the Board considers reinstatement of license, the Board may prescribe additional requirements or restrictions on Dr. Fogari's practice which shall

include but not be limited to a requirement that he shall never again engage in any drug study or research in the State of New Jersey.
