CONSENT ORDER

TO PRACTICE PSYCHOLOGY IN
THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

This matter was opened to the Board of Psychological Examiners ("Board") on the application of Robert J. Del Tufo, Attorney General of New Jersey, by Eleanor G. Bernstein, Deputy Attorney General, by way of an Order to Show Cause and Administrative Complaint filed with the Board. Said complaint alleged sexual misconduct on the part of respondent Erwin Marlin, with offices at 411 Parkview Avenue, Ocean, New Jersey 07712, by three former female patients. Respondent has represented that at the present time he does not intend to practice psychology, as defined below, in any other State. The parties have agreed to a resolution of this matter without the necessity for further

proceedings, and that the resolution contained herein is consistent with the public interest;

IT IS ON THIS 3rd day of August, 1993,

ORDERED:


1. Respondent Erwin Marlin shall have leave to surrender his license to practice psychology in the State of New Jersey with prejudice to seeking reinstatement thereof at any future date. Said surrender shall be made contemporaneously with the entry of the within Order by the Board. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from rendering psychological services in the State of New Jersey.

2. For the purpose of this Order, the practice of psychology shall mean the rendering of professional psychological services to individuals, singly or in groups, whether in the general public or in organizations, either public or private, for a fee, monetary or otherwise. Professional psychological services means the application of psychological principles and procedures in the assessment, counseling or psychotherapy of individuals for the purposes of promoting the optimal development of their potential or ameliorating their personality disturbances and maladjustments as manifested in personal and interpersonal situations. Respondent represents that at the present time he does not intend to practice psychology, as defined above, in any other State.


3. Respondent shall pay plaintiffs' costs in the amount of \$2960.88 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25, as established by


affidavits presented to the Board. This amount shall be paid by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and sent to the attention of Eleanor G. Bernstein, Deputy Attorney General, at the above referenced address contemporaneously with the entry of the within Order by the Board.


