This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry ("Board") upon receipt of a patient complaint from Wanda Santana concerning dental treatment performed by the respondent at Dental 2000, a dental facility in Totowa, N.J., consisting, in pertinent part, of placing crowns on teeth #14 and #15. The Board reviewed the entire record in this matter consisting of the patient's charts, X-rays, insurance records, the records of the subsequent treating dentists, and further information acquired at an investigative inquiry attended by the respondent on May 26, 1993. This review disclosed that the crowns were not properly placed on teeth #14 and #15 and the

margins were over-extended. It also appears to the Board that there was a failure to properly execute the proper sequence of endodontic irrigants. It further appears to the Board that there was a failure to diagnose and evaluate for Temporomandibular Joint Disorders ("TMJ") and a failure to properly diagnose and treat dental pain.

It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 28 DAY OF October, 1993

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:


1. Respondent shall successfully complete fourteen (14) hours of continuing education in basic endodontic treatment, twenty-one (21) hours of continuing education in basic crown and bridge dentistry, and seven (7) hours of continuing education in diagnosis of TMJ disorders for a total of forty-two (42) hours of continuing education. These courses shall be approved by the Board in writing prior to attendance utilizing the attached Pre-Approval Sheet, and the courses must be completed no later than six (6) months from the entry date of the within Order. Respondent also shall be required to complete the attached Continuing Education Report and Proof of Attendance as proof of successful completion of the required course work. The attached

forms are made a part of the within Order, and a separate form is to be used for each course. Said continuing education ordered herein shall be in addition to, and not a part of, the mandatory continuing education currently required for dentists.
