FINAL ORDER

This matter having been opened to the Court on the application of the Attorney General of New Jersey, by Joyce Brown, Deputy Attorney General, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-23, and having been heard on February 18, 1994, and defendant having appeared, and it appearing from the Complaint and Affidavits filed by the Attorney General that Frank Macias has violated N.J.S.A. 45:6-13 and N.J.S.A. 45:6-19, in that he repaired dentures for two undercover investigators posing as patients without a dentist's prescription, and it further appearing that good cause exists for the entry of the within Order;

IT IS ON THIS 20th DAY OF February, 1994,

HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


1. Defendant Frank Macias shall be and hereby is permanently enjoined from engaging in the practice of dentistry and/or offering to engage in the practice of dentistry at any place in the State of New Jersey. For the purpose of this Order, defendant Frank Macias shall not engage in the unlicensed practice of dentistry in any manner whatsoever, with or without compensation, including offers to assist friends and relatives or any other persons, or holding himself out or representing himself as a dentist, or conducting any form of dental examination, or fabricating or repairing dentures without a dentist's prescription, or dispensing a newly fabricated or repaired denture directly to a consumer instead of to a licensed dentist for final evaluation or taking impressions of the human tooth, teeth, jaws or performing any phase of any operation incident to the replacement of a part of a tooth, teeth or associated tissues.

2. Defendant Frank Macias shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars no later than March 31, 1994, by certified check or money order payable to the State of New Jersey and mailed to the State Board of Dentistry at 124 Halsey Street, 6th Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07102.

3. Defendant Frank Macias shall permit unannounced inspections of his business premises by representatives of the Attorney General or the Board of Dentistry and shall fully cooperate in such inspections to assure compliance with the provisions of this Order.
