

before it including the testimony of Dr. Brown and having determined that good cause exists for the entry of an amendment to the Reinstatement Order,

IT IS ON THIS 14 DAY OF APRIL, 1994,

HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The requirement that Dr. Brown practice dentistry only as the employee and under the direct supervision of a New Jersey licensed dentist shall be terminated.

2. Urine monitoring shall be reduced from once weekly to twice monthly for the next six (6) months from the entry date of this Order, then further reduced to once monthly for the subsequent six (6) months. If all urine specimens during this period of time are negative, urine monitoring shall be discontinued in its entirety.

3. Dr. Brown shall attend therapy as recommended by Adele Greenhaus, A.C.S.W., Voorhees, New Jersey. Such therapy shall not be terminated without prior written notice to the Board and written confirmation from the Board approving such termination.

4. Dr. Brown shall be permitted to prescribe controlled dangerous substances strictly in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- a. Dr. Brown shall obtain and exclusively employ prescription pads which provide triplicate copies of each prescription and which are consecutively numbered.
- b. Dr. Brown shall provide the original of the prescription to the patient, he shall place one copy in the patient's chart, and he shall submit one copy of all prescriptions to the Board on a

monthly basis. Dr. Brown shall be required to account for each consecutive number, regardless of whether the particular prescription was voided or not used for any purpose whatsoever.

- c. Dr. Brown shall submit copies of these prescriptions in consecutive order no later than the fifth day of each month for all prescriptions written in the previous month. These copies shall be submitted to Agnes Clarke, Executive Director of the Board of Dentistry, at 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07102, so that they may be reviewed and monitored by the Board.

5. All other terms and conditions of the Reinstatement Order entered on January 13, 1993 which are not inconsistent with the within Order shall continue in full force and effect.

6. The terms of this amended Reinstatement Order shall be effective upon the entry of this Order.
