CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened before the Board of Medical Examiners in July 1992 upon the complaint of the Attorney General of New Jersey, by Brenda Talbot Lewis, Deputy Attorney General. Frederick Coville, M.D., who was represented by Kern, Augustine, Conroy & Schoppmann, P.A., entered into a Consent Order in May 1993 and Dr. Coville's license was suspended for four years, the first three years to be stayed with restrictions. These restrictions included the requirement that Dr. Coville practice medicine only pursuant to a bona fide employment relationship, that he not perform any cosmetic procedures, and that he conduct all examinations or treatments of female patients in the presence of a chaperon.

The matter was reopened before the Board by Deborah T. Poritz, Attorney General of New Jersey, Brenda Talbot Lewis, Deputy

Attorney General appearing, seeking to discontinue the stay of the suspension and to impose in its place an active suspension. By Order of May 8, 1994, the Board found that Dr. Coville had violated the Consent Order and had seen female patients without a chaperon. The Board ordered that Dr. Coville's license be actively suspended for a period of six months beginning May 8, 1994 and ending November 17, 1994, and that Dr. Coville appear before a Preliminary Evaluation Committee prior to the end of the active portion of the suspension. Dr. Coville was also ordered to pay the costs of investigation.

Dr. Coville appeared before the Preliminary Evaluation Committee on October 26, 1994, represented by Robert J. Conroy, Esq. Based on his testimony and evidence offered, the Board determined that Dr. Coville may resume the practice of medicine only under strictly controlled circumstances to which he must agree. Based on that agreement,

IT IS



ORDERED that Frederick Coville, M.D., may resume the active practice of medicine only pursuant to a bona fide employment relationship with a licensed physician who signs this Order signifying his agreement to supervise Dr. Coville, to ensure that Dr. Coville does not perform any cosmetic surgery, to submit reports to the Board every six months, and to report immediately any effort by Dr. Coville to circumvent the provisions of this Order, and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Coville may examine and treat female patients only in the presence of a chaperon who shall be employed at his expense, who must be a licensed health practitioner, and who signs this Order signifying her agreement to act as a chaperon, to submit reports to the Board every six months, and to report immediately any effort by Dr. Coville to circumvent the provisions of this Order, and it is further


ORDERED that Dr. Coville may employ more than one chaperon, each of whom shall be subject to the requirements of this Order.


