REVISED ORDER

This matter is opened to the Board upon application of Allan B. Martin, M.D. to modify the previous Consent order entered into on July 14, 1993 wherein respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in New Jersey was restricted based upon his abuse of alcohol.

Respondent appeared before a Committee of the Board for the purpose of discussing his participation in an aftercare program under the supervision of the Physicians Health Program. Dr. Canavan appeared and offered a memorandum of support of respondent's application, wherein Dr. Canavan reported that respondent had undergone random urine screens for the presence of alcohol all of which were negative.

Respondent's original Order limited his medical practice to Perth Amboy Hospital, which employment caused respondent to experience

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significant hardship due to the 3,500 mile weekly commute from his residence in Southern New Jersey.

Respondent has complied with the terms and conditions of the July 14, 1993 Order. Therefore, the Board will modify the terms of the Order of July 14, 1993 as specified below. It appears that this Order is adequately protective of the public interest and good cause, therefore, exists for its entry.

IT IS THEREFORE, ON THIS 1st DAY OF May 1995

ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall continue with participation in the aftercare program as required by the P.H.P.
2. Respondent may seek alternative employment within an institutional setting in a geographic location closer to his place of residence.
3. Respondent shall notify the Board of his ~~acceptance of alternate employment.~~

4. Respondent shall immediately notify the Board of any change in any subsequent employment.
5. Respondent shall refrain from any and all aspects of the private practice of medicine prior to receipt of express written authority from the Board to engage in such practice.
