CONSENT ORDER

This matter having been opened to the Court by the State of New Jersey, Board of Medical Examiners, by Deborah T. Paras, Attorney General of New Jersey, counsel for plaintiff, Brenda Talbot Lewis, Deputy Attorney General, appearing, and Robert J. Candido, Esq., appearing for defendant Anthony Basil, and it having been alleged that defendant was offering to render equine dental services, holding himself out as being a veterinarian and practicing veterinarian medicine within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 45:16-8.1, which constituted the practice of veterinary medicine and dentistry in the State of New Jersey without a license in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:16-9, and defendant ~~having admitted to the allegations and~~ wishing to resolve

this matter without the necessity for further proceedings, and the Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners being satisfied that this Consent Order is adequately protective of the public health and welfare,

IT IS on this 1st day of April, 1996,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Defendant Anthony Basil shall and hereby is restrained from the unlicensed practice of veterinary medicine; AND DEFENDANT SHALL NOTIFY, AND OBTAIN THE APPROVAL FROM A LICENSED VETERINARIAN PRIOR TO PERFORMING ANY SERVICES;

2. Defendant Anthony Basil shall pay to the Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 and costs of investigation in this matter of \$1,692.58;

3. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:16-8.1(6) defendant Anthony Basil shall be permitted to work as an equine dental technician solely under the responsible supervision and direction of a veterinarian licensed by the Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners; SUCH SUPERVISION SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO REQUIRE THE ACTUAL PRESENCE OF THE VETERINARIAN UNLESS, IN THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE VETERINARIAN, SUCH PRESENCE IS REQUIRED.
