THIS MATTER, having been open to the Court by Peter Verniero, Attorney General of the State of New Jersey by Denise A. Cobham, Deputy Attorney General, as Attorney for the plaintiffs, Attorney General of the State of New Jersey and New Jersey Board of Psychological Examiners, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-18 and 23 as well as R.4:52-1, and it appearing from the testimony partially adduced on the complaint and affidavits and/or certification submitted therewith before the Court on Monday, January 13, 1997 that defendant James A. Huddy, Ph.D. has been engaging and continues to engage in the unlicensed practice of the profession of psychology and poses a clear and imminent danger



to the public health, safety and welfare, and the Court having determined to grant respondent's further application for an adjournment, over objection by plaintiffs, in order to provide defendant with another opportunity to obtain counsel, and the Court having found that due cause exists for the entry of the within order,

IT IS ON THIS 5th day of *March*, 1997 ORDERED:

1. That the request of the defendant James A. Huddy, for a second adjournment in order to obtain counsel is hereby granted;

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

2. That defendant James A. Huddy is ordered to show cause before the Superior Court of New Jersey, Chancery Division, Ocean County, 118 Washington Street, Courtroom 8, Toms River, New Jersey (Honorable William H. Huber) on *a date to be agreed upon within 7 days of the date of this Order,*
~~the~~ ~~day of~~ , 1997 at ~~a.m. or as soon thereafter as counsel may~~
~~be heard~~, why, after summary hearing, an order should not be entered:

(a) permanently enjoining said defendant from representing himself as a licensed psychologist and from offering to practice, attempting to practice and practicing the profession of psychology in the State of New Jersey without first securing the license so to do, as required by N.J.S.A. 45:14B-1 et seq., and particularly N.J.S.A. 45:14B-2(b),

(b) assessing civil penalties, restitution and costs for the unlicensed practice of psychology in New Jersey and any other relief the Court finds necessary and just,

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED,

3. That the defendant is restrained from all contact with present, former, current and/or new patients/clients until further order of this Court. The defendant shall not perform services, whether for remuneration or otherwise, for present, former, current and/or new patients/clients regardless of whether he holds or attempts to hold himself out as a counselor, psychotherapist, psychologist, psychoanalyst, therapist or other mental health care worker and/or professional except as to record requests for former patients or other professionals. Such records include bills. This shall also include appearance in any court of competent jurisdiction or administrative hearing as an expert witness or a fact witness unless Dr. Huddy notifies the court and/or hearing officer that his license to practice psychology was revoked as of November 1, 1996. This shall also include the preparation of any report, written or oral, upon which any professional, third party payor or tribunal may rely unless Dr. Huddy notifies the requester of the report that his license to practice psychology was revoked as of November 1, 1996.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

3a. That the Interim Order of Restraint dated January 16, 1997, be and hereby is VACATED.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

4. That the defendant shall be permitted to accept payment of fees for professional services rendered prior to November 1, 1996. However, the defendant must make a full accounting to the Court of any fees obtained. The accounting shall include the source and amount of the payment, the date received, the date requested, and the dates of professional services rendered, until further of this Court.
