

restrained from holding himself out as either a licensed psychologist or an unlicensed psychologist with regard to the treatment of patients/clients or the counseling of patients/clients. This settlement, as placed on the record on June 9, 1997, renders permanent the Interim Restraints put in place by Order of March 5, 1997, with the minor exceptions set forth herein, unless and until Dr. Huddy is issued a license to practice psychology in this State.

IT IS ORDERED that Dr. Huddy will remit to the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners \$2,000.00 in the form of money order on June 9, 1997 as partial payment for fines previously levied by the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Huddy will remit to the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners \$8,000.00 on or before August 8, 1997 as additional payment for the fines levied by the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the balance of the fines and costs of \$10,000.00 will be paid to the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners on or before November 1, 1997; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an additional \$1,000.00 will be paid again to the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners on or before December 1, 1997; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners through its counsel will provide the names of three psychologists within a 30-mile radius area of Dr. Huddy's residence and Dr. Huddy will comply with all of the recommendations made by the psychologist and attend recommended reasonably psychologist's sessions; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Huddy will attend these sessions in good faith and as previously stated will comply with all reasonable recommendations of the selected psychologist;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a member of the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners Enforcement Bureau has the option once every month up until Dr. Huddy is relicensed by the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners to inspect Dr. Huddy's office (not his residence) for the purposes of evaluating whether the terms of this Order are being complied with; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Huddy will immediately desist and not perform any services or hold himself out as a counselor, psychotherapist, psychologist, psychoanalyst or any other medical healthcare worker or professional until such time as Dr. Huddy's license to practice psychology is reinstated and/or further Order of the Court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Huddy shall (has already provided to the Deputy Attorney General), the names of

three cases which are pending wherein he is acting as an expert witness. With regard to these three cases, Dr. Huddy is to provide advance notice to the Deputy Attorney General's office and the Court when the hearings are to occur and his attendance is required. With regard to any monies earned from these three Court cases, these monies will be turned over to his attorney and forwarded to the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners as partial payment for the monies owed that are previously referred to in this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served upon all counsel within 10 days of the date hereof.
