This matter was opened before the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") upon the Board's receipt of a report of investigation and recommendations from the Medical Practitioner Review Panel (the "Panel") concerning respondent Satyeswara K. Sarode, M.D. The Panel's investigation of this matter was commenced upon receipt of a report from St. Peter's Medical Center suggesting that respondent's application for hospital privileges at St. Peter's had been denied because he failed to fully disclose information concerning post graduate training during 1987 and 1988 at Sinai Hospital in Detroit, Michigan, and for the inclusion of other misstatements of fact within respondent's privilege application.

The Panel reviewed documentation concerning this matter, to include information supplied by St. Peter's Medical Center and by Sinai Hospital, and had opportunity to consider testimony offered by respondent when he appeared before the Panel on March 21, 1997. Upon review of all available information, the Panel found that respondent in fact made three material misrepresentations within his application for hospital privileges at St. Peters; specifically, respondent (1) failed to disclose material information concerning residency training received at Sinai Hospital in Detroit, Michigan; (2) failed to disclose that he had been denied hospital privileges at St. Vincent's Hospital in Staten Island, New York; and (3) falsely stated that he was affiliated with Robert Wood Johnson Hospital, when in fact respondent was not so affiliated. Based

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thereon, the Panel concluded that cause for disciplinary sanction against Dr. Sarode existed pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b). The Board, in turn, has reviewed and ratified the report and findings of the Panel.

The parties desiring to resolve this matter without formal proceedings, and it appearing further that respondent has read the terms of the within Order, understands those terms and consents to entry of this Order by the Board, and respondent hereby waiving any rights that he may have to the holding of a formal administrative hearing, and for good cause shown:

IT IS, on this day of , 1997

ORDERED:

1. Respondent Satyeswara K. Sarode is hereby reprimanded for having made material omissions of information and misstatements of fact within an application he filed for hospital privileges with St. Peter's Medical Center.


2. Respondent is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00, which penalty shall be paid in full upon signing of this Order.
