This matter was opened to the State Board of Psychological Examiners ("Board") upon receipt of a complaint from L.G. and A.G. concerning a psychological assessment performed for their son, J.G., in the period June to July 1996. The Board reviewed the entire record in this matter including a response and information submitted by the respondent. It appears to the Board that during a period commencing in or about June 1996 the respondent practiced psychology in this State notwithstanding that she did not possess a license in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:14B-5,6. Further, it appears respondent did not file an application for a license to practice psychology in this State until January 1997 and was not granted a temporary permit to practice psychology in this State pending licensure until August 1997.

It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without further proceedings, and that the within Order is entered without any findings or admissions of wrongdoing, and the Board finding the entry of this Order to be in the public interest,

IT IS ON THIS 28th DAY OF November, 1997,

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000.00. Said penalty shall be paid by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and submitted to the Board of Psychological Examiners at 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey 07102, no later than the first day of the month following the entry date of the within Order. Respondent may elect by notice to the Executive Director of the Board in writing, to pay the penalty in installments over a period of one year. In that case each monthly payment of \$166.67 shall be due no later than the first day of each month. Any failure to make a timely payment shall cause the entire remaining balance to be immediately due and payable.
