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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy ("Board") by receipt of information that respondent had consumed excessive amounts of alcohol and marijuana on or about April 11, 1997. Respondent, after being found incapacitated while on duty at Monmouth Medical Center, refused to take a toxicology test when treated at the Medical Center Emergency Room.

Respondent appeared before the Board on November 12, 1997, and testified under oath in response to questions from Board members

In the event of any such alteration or modification the Board shall give timely notice of any new testing requirement to the respondent.

3. In the event respondent is unable to appear for a scheduled urine test due to illness or other impossibility, consent to waive that day's test must be secured from the Board office. The monitor will not be authorized to provide consent. In addition, respondent must provide the Board with written substantiation for his inability to appear, e.g. physician's report.

4. Respondent hereby consents to the entry of an Order of Automatic Suspension of his license without notice upon the Board's receipt of any reliable information such as, but not limited to, a report of a confirmed positive urine or any information which reveals evidence of substance abuse during the probationary period.

5. Respondent shall have the right to apply for removal of the automatic suspension on two (2) days notice, but in such event shall be limited to a showing that urine tested was not his or was a false positive, in the case of urine testing, or that other information submitted was false.
