Respondent continued to practice pharmacy at White Oak Pharmacy and represented to his employer that he was at all times currently licensed.

On or about February of 1998 respondent passed the Board of Pharmacy law exam, submitted documentation of his completion of 75 continuing education credits and paid to the Board reinstatement, application and current renewal fees, and thereafter, was reinstated to current active licensure.

Respondent, admitting to the aforementioned conduct, and the parties having agreed and consented to the resolution of this matter without the necessity of further proceedings, and respondent

understanding the terms and conditions of the within Order, and it therefore appearing that due cause exists for the entry of the within Order,

IT IS ON THIS 27th DAY OF May, 1998

ORDERED AND AGREED:

1. The license of Richard Zuzzio, R.P. to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey is hereby suspended for six months; three months of said suspension shall be active and three months shall be stayed.

2. Respondent shall pay all renewal fees due and owing from 1991 to date, a \$2,500 civil penalty and costs for the use of the State in this matter upon receipt of an affidavit of costs from the Executive Director of the Board of Pharmacy.
