This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon the receipt of information that Robert Nassi had pled guilty on October 22, 1997 to Criminal Diversion of Prescription Legend Drugs specifically, Depakote, Epogen, Dilantin, Biaxin, Prilosec, Zolofit, Tetracycline, and Coumadin and was sentenced to a conditioned discharge and ordered to make restitution of \$10,000.

Respondent being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and respondent having agreed to abide by the terms of the within Order, and for good cause shown,

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS *12th* DAY OF *Aug* 1998,

ORDERED AND AGREED:

1. Respondent Robert Nassi, R.P. voluntarily agrees to a revocation of his license to practice pharmacy effective immediately with prejudice to making application for reinstatement for three (3) years.

2. Effective with the revocation of his license, Robert Nassi shall cease and desist in the practice of pharmacy in any manner or form, including but not limited to the following: he shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; he shall not engage in the acceptance of any prescription in person or by telephone; he shall not engage in the verification of refill authorization by telephone; he shall not advise or consult with any person concerning the properties and actions of drugs.
