

performing embryo transfer procedures, and that such procedures constitute the practice of veterinary medicine, and respondent not being in possession of a license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of New Jersey, and all parties having agreed to the entry of this Order and other good cause existing therefor,

IT IS on this 21st day of October, 1998

ORDERED that respondent Daniel V. Chard shall cease and desist the practice of veterinary medicine unless and until such time as he is legally licensed to do so practice, except that he shall not be barred from performing embryo transplants with animals that he owns, and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall pay to the New Jersey State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners a penalty in the amount of \$500.00.
