CONSENT ORDER

In September 1996 an Administrative Complaint was filed on behalf of the State Board of Medical Examiners. Thereafter, an answer was filed on behalf of respondent and the matter was transferred to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing. This matter is scheduled to be heard before ALJ Reiner in August 1998.

After further investigation and with the parties being desirous of resolving this matter,

IT IS HEREBY on this 22 day of October 1998,

AGREED:

1. Respondent, Suketu Nanavati, M.D., is hereby reprimanded for maintaining records which fail to specifically adhere to each of the technical requirements of N.J.A.C. 13:35-6.5.

2. Respondent shall pay investigative costs in the amount of \$5,485.35.




