This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Accountancy upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed and on which the following findings of fact and conclusions of law are made:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is a Public Accountant in the State of New Jersey and has been a licensee at all times relevant hereto.

2. On June 6, 1997 respondent was convicted of a crime of Theft by Deception in Superior Court of New Jersey, Atlantic County. Specifically, respondent knowingly deposited in his own account counterfeit checks and thereafter withdrew these funds by drafting checks on his account (Copy of Judgment of Conviction and

Special Notice of Indictment annexed hereto and made a part hereof).

3. The following sentence was ordered: three (3) years probation and restitution of \$15,000.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The above conviction provides grounds for the suspension of his license to practice accountancy in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f) in that the crime of which respondent was convicted is one of moral turpitude and/or relates adversely to the practice of accountancy.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ON THIS 19th DAY OF Jan., 1998,
ORDERED that:

1. Respondent's license to practice accountancy in the State of New Jersey is hereby revoked.
