This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Accountancy by receipt of information that Respondent has held himself out to the public as an accountant in the State of New Jersey without being licensed, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:2B-23(e). Mr. Campisi has used stationery bearing his name, with the title "Public Accountant", and has represented to the public that he is a public accountant. Respondent, admitting to the aforementioned conduct, and the parties having agreed and consented to the resolution of this matter without the necessity of the Board seeking injunctive relief in the Superior Court of New Jersey, and respondent understanding the terms and impact of the within Order,

IT IS ON THIS *14th* DAY OF *June*, 1999,

ORDERED AND AGREED:


1. Respondent shall cease and desist holding himself out to the public as a public accountant licensed in the State of New Jersey. He shall not use any stationery, rubber stamps, business

cards, taped messages or other representations indicating he is a public accountant licensed in New Jersey, nor shall he sign any client's income tax form with the designation "public accountant" with a New Jersey address.


2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$1,000.00 and costs of \$500.00 for the use of the State.

3. In the event respondent violates paragraph number one of the within Order, respondent hereby consents to the entry of a preliminary injunction to be deemed a subsequent offense in the Superior Court on verified application by the Attorney General appearing on behalf of the State Board of Accountancy with notice to Respondent.
