

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy by receipt of information that on October 13, 1998 respondent had been charged with theft from his employer, Boyd's Pharmacy in Bordentown, New Jersey, of approximately \$11,000. Respondent, in an effort to resolve the criminal and the administrative matters contemporaneously has agreed to make restitution of \$11,000 be placed on criminal probation for a three year term, and surrender his pharmacy license for the duration of the criminal probation.

Respondent wishing to voluntarily surrender his license to practice pharmacy, and the parties having agreed and consented to the resolution of this matter without the necessity of formal administrative proceedings available before the Board, and respondent understanding the terms and impact of the within Order,

and it therefore appearing that due cause exists for the entry of the within Order,

IT IS ON THIS 16th DAY OF August, 1999,

ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall have leave to surrender at the Office of the State Board of Pharmacy, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey, both the original certificate and the most current renewal. Such surrender of respondent's license to practice pharmacy shall be made contemporaneously with the entry of the within Order and shall be with prejudice to seeking the reinstatement thereof for a minimum of three (3) years from the date of entry of the within Order.

2. That upon the surrender of his license to practice pharmacy, respondent shall cease and desist the practice of pharmacy including the following: respondent shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; he shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; he shall not handle prescriptions; he shall not advise or consult with patients, and he is prohibited from being present within a prescription filing area of a pharmacy.
