


This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy by the receipt of information alleging that respondent had been diverting Controlled Dangerous Substances for her own use from her employer Pompton Nursing Home Suppliers.

On September 22, 1999 Respondent appeared before a Committee of the Board and testified under oath in response to questions from the Board members. Ms. Werbin acknowledged that she had diverted three adipex and three tylenol with codeine for her own personal use, but represented that this was the only occasion in which diversion occurred. She expressed her remorse for her poor judgment but denied any ongoing controlled drug use. The Board has considered respondent's testimony and has determined

the following disciplinary action to be adequately protective of the public.

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 15th DAY OF Nov, 1999,

ORDERED AND AGREED, pending further order of the Board that the license of Maris Werbin, R.P. to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey is hereby suspended for one year from the entry of this Order; and that all of said suspension is hereby stayed.

2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$2,500 to the Board within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of this Order, and costs for use of the State within thirty (30) days of receipt of an Affidavit of Costs from the Executive Director of the Board.

3. Respondent shall have her urine monitored at her own expense on a random unannounced basis for the entire stayed suspension period on a weekly basis with direct witnessing of the samples. The initial drug screen will utilize the EMIT technique and all conforming tests and/or secondary tests will be performed by gas chromatographing/mass spectrometry (GC/MS). The testing procedure shall include a forensic documentation thereof.

4. The result of all tests shall be reported directly to H. Lee Gladstein, Executive Director of the Board, or his designee in the event he is unavailable. The Board, at anytime, may alter or modify the manner of the testing directed herein. In the event of any such alteration or modification the Board shall give timely notice of any new testing requirement to the respondent.

5. In the event respondent is unable to appear for a scheduled urine test due to illness or other impossibility, consent to waive that day's test must be secured from the Board office. The lab will not be authorized to provide consent. In addition, respondent must provide the Board with a written substantiation of her inability to appear, e.g. physician's report.

6. Any failure to appear for a urine test for which consent is not secured from the Board and for which no written substantiation is furnished satisfactory to the Board within two (2) days of such failure to appear shall be grounds for activation of the suspension upon short notice.

7. Respondent shall not use or possess any controlled dangerous substances, except for bona fide medical purposes as deemed necessary by a physician or other authorized prescriber during the entire period of probation. In such event, respondent is to serve notice to the Board in writing.
