

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon the receipt of information that on or about Friday, October 29, 1999 Michael Sedotti pled guilty to Failure to Make Required Disposition of Controlled Dangerous Substances in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10. Specifically, respondent received anabolic steroids, a Schedule III Controlled Dangerous Substance, without a valid prescription.

It appearing that respondent acknowledges the above described conduct, and further acknowledges that the conduct constitutes professional misconduct in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), and

respondent being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and all parties having agreed to the terms and entry of the within Order, and for good cause shown,

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS DAY OF ,1999,

ORDERED AND AGREED:

1. The license of Respondent Michael Sedotti, R.P. to practice pharmacy is hereby suspended for one (1) year from the date of entry of the within Order. The first six months (6) of said suspension shall be active; the remaining six (6) months shall be stayed and become a period of probation.

2. Respondent shall be on probation for the duration of the stayed suspension, subject to compliance with paragraphs 3 through 6 herein. If respondent violates any of the provisions of paragraph 3 through 6 herein, the Board may initiate proceedings to revoke his probationary status and to actively suspend or revoke his license to practice pharmacy.

3. Respondent shall have his urine monitored at his own expense on a random, unannounced basis ^{two (2)} ~~one~~ (1) time per ^{month} ~~week~~ for the second six months of the suspension.

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4. The result of all tests shall be reported directly to H. Lee Gladstein, Executive Director of the Board or his successor, or

his designee in the event he is unavailable. The Board may at anytime alter or modify the manner of the testing directed herein. In the event of any such alteration or modification the Board shall give timely notice of any new testing requirement to the respondent.

5. In the event respondent, Michael Sedotti, is unable to appear for a scheduled urine test due to illness or other impossibility, consent to waive that day's test must be secured from the Board office. The lab or monitor will not be authorized to provide consent. In addition, Mr. Sedotti must provide the Board with any written substantiation which may be obtained for his inability to appear, e.g. physician's report.

6. Any failure to appear for a urine test for which consent is not secured from the Board and for which no written substantiation is furnished satisfactory to the Board within two (2) days of such failure to appear, shall be grounds for activation of the suspension upon short notice.

7. Respondent shall pay the Board's costs for investigation in this matter, which shall be determined at a later date upon submission of an Affidavit of Costs from the Board's Executive Director.

8. All costs associated with the monitoring program as outlined herein shall be paid directly by Respondent. Upon application for reinstatement, Respondent shall appear before the Board to demonstrate his fitness to resume active practice and that costs of urine monitoring, and costs to the State, have been paid in full.


