

incompetence in connection with radiology services and other screening services for the detection of breast cancer. These allegations, if proven, would demonstrate that Respondent's continued licensure in this State poses an imminent threat to the public health, safety and welfare of New Jersey's citizenry.

Respondent now seeks leave to voluntarily cease and desist from engaging in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey without prejudice and in accordance with the terms of this Order, pending resolution of the hearing regarding his summary suspension from practice in the State of New York. The Board, finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,


IT IS, therefore, on this 26th day of June, 2000,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent, L. Mario DiBlasio, M.D., is hereby granted leave and shall immediately cease and desist from practicing medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey until such time as the aforementioned summary suspension is resolved before the New York Medical Board;
2. Prior to resuming the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey, Respondent shall provide the Board with evidence that his license to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in New York is without limitations, and, at the discretion of the Board, Respondent shall appear before the Board or a committee thereof, to demonstrate that he is capable of performing the functions of a licensee in a manner consistent with the public's health, safety and welfare;


3. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order is without prejudice to further action by this Board or other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct prior to his resumption of practice in New Jersey.
